



TERMS OF ENROLLMENT

2009/2010 Academic Year

Omni Montessori School is dedicated to offering an authentic Montessori educational experience to all children who attend. We understand that parents who pursue a Montessori education for their child are also committed to this goal. Because children are “learning all the time” parents need to take the responsibility to familiarize themselves with Montessori principles and remain informed as their child moves through the program.

The terms of enrollment listed here are designed to inform and educate parents, and to foster community building within the school; all for the purpose of benefiting the children in our care.

Please read these carefully, sign below and return with your Registration Agreement.

1. I/we recognize that it is necessary for Montessori principles to become fully interwoven in our child’s life. Our willingness to support and implement the Montessori approach will create this consistent and harmonious experience for our child.
2. I/we agree to attend Parent Education evenings, in order to understand and support the school’s work on behalf of our child.
3. I/we understand and agree that our child is enrolled for the entire school year.
4. I/we agree to read, understand and follow the policies set forth in the school’s Parent Handbook, along with any additions or changes to these policies.
5. I/we agree to monitor our child’s participation in outside activities, their sleep and punctual arrival at school in order to create a lifestyle that is unhurried and supportive for him/her.
6. I/we agree to pursue outside academic help if/when the School recommends such additional help. I/we will work in partnership with the School in the selection of any outside academic assistance.
7. I/we acknowledge that while Registration Contracts are entered into for one academic year at a time, the school, in keeping with the Montessori philosophy, requires that children be enrolled with the intent of completing a full cycle of the program. The first cycle being from age three through six, the second being from age six through twelve.
8. I/we are informed, or are willing to become informed, about the effects of technology media (computers, video games, and the like) on the developing child, and agree to control usage of these, in keeping with the spirit of the Montessori philosophy.
9. I/we understand the importance of parental involvement in support of the School community and thus the success of our child’s education. As such, I/we agree to become involved in the school’s community through volunteering my/our time on the Board of Trustees, the Parent Association, various committees, or in the classrooms.
