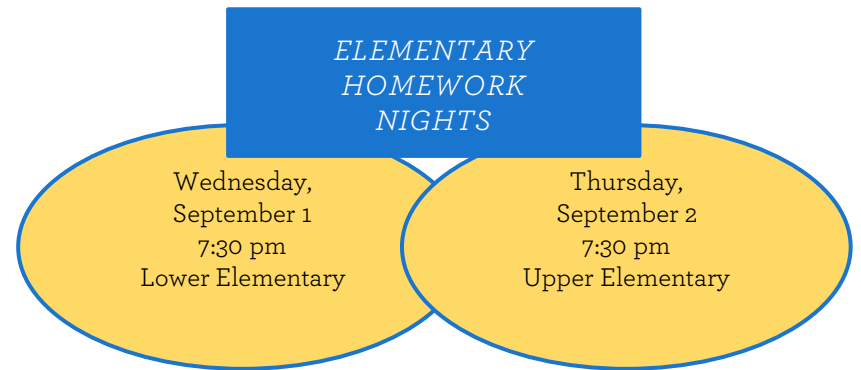
OCTOBER 2021 – APRIL 2022
